



Légalement robust, mais facile à comprendre !






Attribution (BY)

Toutes les licences CC obligent à mentionner le nom de l'auteur initial.



Non commercial (NC)

Interdiction de tirer un profit commercial de l'œuvre.



Pas de modifications (ND)

Ne pas changer l'œuvre, toujours le laisser en son entièreté.



Partage à l'identique (SA)

Rediffuser selon la même licence ou une licence similaire (version ultérieure ou localisée).


